Guideline synthesis for Internet surfing in the Faenza City Library

<u>The service</u> allows a temporary connection to the web in Wifi mode through <u>stable stations</u> offered by the Library or <u>mobile devices</u> owned by the users; the service is <u>for free</u>. Technical support from the Library operators is not included.

<u>Subscription to the service:</u> a valid <u>identification</u> must be shown; <u>underaged</u> users must be accompanied by a parent or a guardian ad litem, both equipped with valid identifications. The parent must endorse an authorization to the underage to surf the web in her/his absence.

After the subscription the <u>log-in information</u> will be released. They are strictly personal and can not be given to others. Whenever a <u>loss</u> may occurr, the reprint of log-in information costs a fee of $\leq 1,00$.

<u>Stable stations:</u> the navigation can last <u>1 hour per day maximum</u>. The user is invited to <u>logout</u> at the end of each session. The access to the device is allowed for <u>no more than two persons</u>.

Any moment the operator could <u>ask the users for log-in information</u> and/or identifications in order to verify the correctness of the connection profile.

<u>Wifi mode:</u> navigation through private devices is limitless. In case of network overload the Library has the discretion to limit the daily duration of surfing.

<u>Users rules of counduct</u>: The user is <u>responsible</u> for every activity done during the internet connection. It is <u>forbidden</u>:

- to surf on sites contrasting the service purposes (pedophilic, pornographic, racist sites, etc.);
- to work in order to evade or deceive the control security systems of internal or public servers (hacking);
- to use technological devices in order to infringe the software copyright, to reveal passwords, to identify security flaws, to decrypt encrypted files or to compromise the network security;
- to do anything contrasting the current italian and european legislation;
- to disturb other users, especially with annoying noises.
- to <u>use the log-in information</u> of another user. The operator will immediately stop both profiles; following a suspension (as written in the following paragraph).

<u>Penalties:</u> Following an assured violation of one of the rules, and proportionally to its gravity, the Library operator is able to:

- a) <u>stop</u> the session commanding the user to leave immediately the device, and blocking the service access all day long;
- b) stop the session with a suspension proposal: the suspension will have effect immediately and will last at least until the Municipal Culture Supervisor will decide for a definite disciplinary action. The action will enter into force within 7 days and will last from 7 to 60 days according to the gravity of the violation.

Together with the sospension is stricly forbidden to the user also the navigation side by side to others.
